

For the following SCIM table entries:

When a letter is composable (underlined) any keyboard key not in the first column above will have the effect of terminating the entry, no further compositions are possible. The exception here is Backspace which will un-compose a character by one keystroke (as per current SCIM behavior which is ok).
